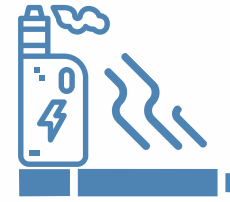
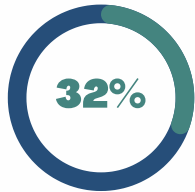

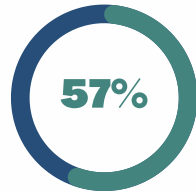
16 out of 50 tobacco retailers in Clark County sold tobacco products to underage youth.

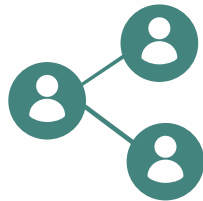

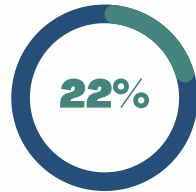

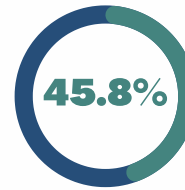

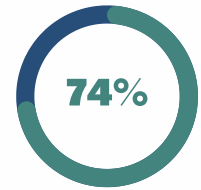
